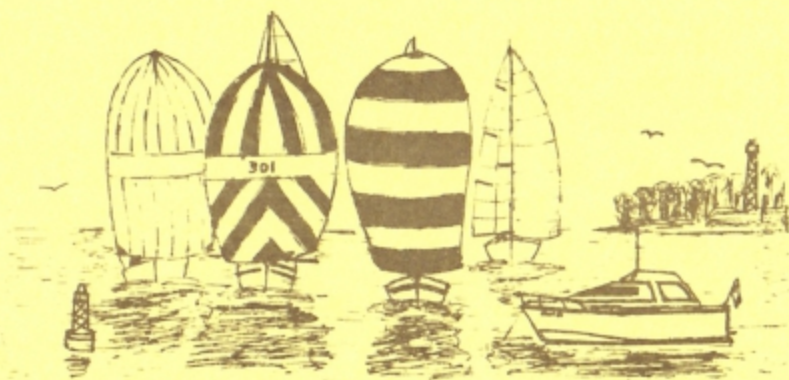

Membership forms will be accompanying this newsletter and we would like to have them back as soon as possible for our 1985 Roster in June.

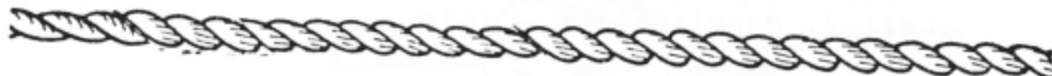
