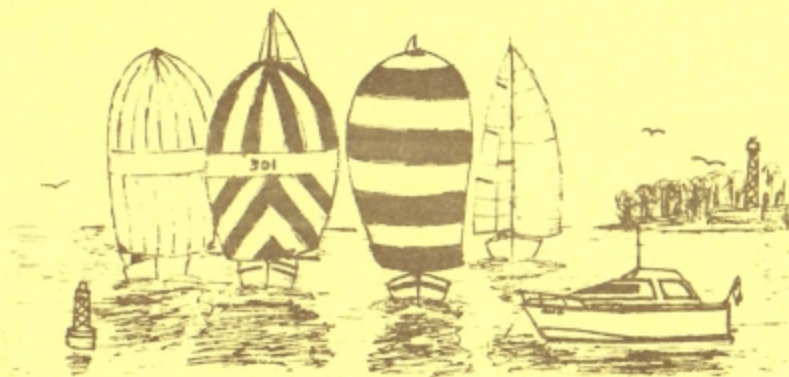

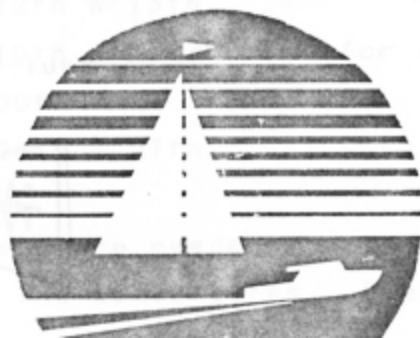

Operating out of Collins Bay Marina some five miles west of Kingston, Ontario, the Collins Bay Yacht Club was founded in 1980 by a group of boaters from the marina who had gotten together for some informal racing. Today, with well over one hundred family memberships representing both sail and power enthusiasts, we try to maintain the informal, friendly aspect of our club.

For the racers we put on spring, summer, and fall series of Thursday night races as well as three to five longer distance (up to 30 miles) events. The cruisers can participate in up to six or seven weekend cruises to destinations within a 20-30 mile radius, as well as a week long mid-summer excursion. (We've had over 25 boats in a raft at Prinyer's Cove.) Family Day, barbeques, Junior events, awards banquet round out our activities.

We send courtesy cards to over 50 clubs on Lake Ontario and the St. Lawrence, and although our facilities are minimal at present, we can offer visitors a free night in a member's vacant slip. We hope to acquire a permanent club house in the near future and having survived the formative years have elected to join the CYA this year.

Stop in and see us if you are in the area. You'll find the members helpful, informative, and very friendly.
