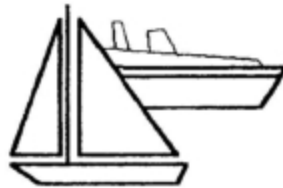

Collins Bay Yacht Club Sailing Camp

Collins Bay Yacht Club is offering a sail training day camp for youth nine years of age and older and an adult evening program. The day camp is a weekly program from June 28 to August 20, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Instruction is by Canadian Yachting Association certified instructors in CBYC dinghys; CYA Certificates of Achievement are awarded upon completion of each level.

White Sail (Levels I, II & III) cover basic sailing knowledge, safety procedures, rules of the road and plenty of sailing. Bronze Sail (Levels IV & V) include spinnakers, heavy weather sailing, advanced theory and boat maintenance. Silver Sail (Levels VI) provide an introduction to racing.

The camp is on the grounds of Collins Bay Marina with sailing on Collins Bay providing protected waters and good breezes. Fees for the youth programme are \$130 (members \$120) per week: an adult evening program is also available at \$80 (members \$70) per session.
