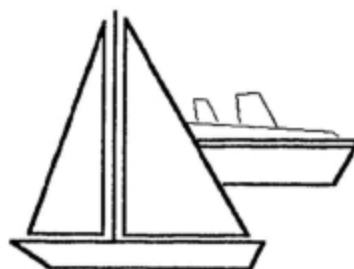

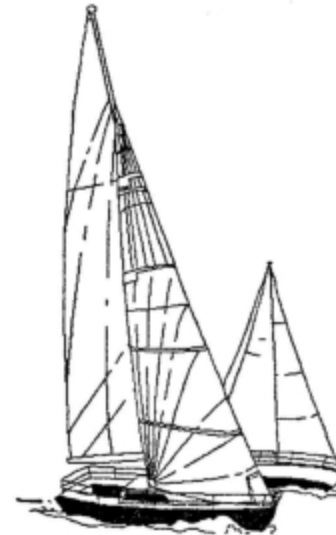
Racing
