CRUISE LEADER

BACKGROUND: As part of its summer program schedule, Collins Bay Yacht Club has always named a Cruise Captain for each cruise, to coordinate cruises with pre-planned destinations. One of the results of our 1992 cruise questionnaire suggested that members may not be as interested in cruises with pre-planned destinations as they might be in deciding on an ad hoc basis the destination for a cruise given conditions of wind and weather on the day of departure. The Cruise Leader is a volunteer recruited from amongst the Club's membership to coordinate a weekend or holiday cruise. The person thus selected usually has had considerable experience cruising local waters, is capable, though not obligated, to provide advice regarding issues such as comfort and safety.

It is suggested that the name "cruise captain" be changed to that of "cruise leader" because the word "captain" suggests more authority, and therefore more responsibility than the person coordinating the cruise should be required to assume.

DUTIES:

1) Coordinate Saturday morning 9:30 a.m., cruise meeting of those participating in the weekend or holiday cruise.

2) Given conditions of wind and weather, achieve consensus on the **DESTINATION FOR THE DAY**, making and receiving suggestions from those participating.

3) **ESTABLISH METHODS OF COMMUNICATION.** Channel to monitor; channel to be used for all vessel communication, etc.

4) **COORDINATE COMMUNICATIONS** during the days sail to the destination. Most of our members have VHF, and generally communicate cruise plans to others who may have left messages of their potential interest in participation. Establish a method for receiving information from those who may already have departed but who may wish to join. **STRESS THAT THOSE WHO HAVE INDICATED THEIR INTENTION TO PARTICIPATE AND CHANGE THEIR DECISION, THAT FOR SAFETY THEY MUST INDICATE THEIR CHANGE OF PLANS TO THE CRUISE COORDINATOR.**

CRUISE LEADER - CONTINUED

5) At the destination, ensure that the whereabouts of all vessels is known. Attempt, if possible to communicate with late arrivals. If a vessel fails to arrive, and conditions warrant, request Coast Guard to attempt to call missing vessel to determine their whereabouts and intentions.

SAFETY: Impress on all vessels that the Cruise Leader is not responsible for safety of other vessels, other than his/hers, or for **safety decisions** that may have to be made should there be a sudden worsening of conditions. If plans change, the role of the coordinator is to communicate this change to other vessels. Because of a change in the weather, the coordinator may make, or accept a recommendation for a change in destination, or may decide to press on to the original destination. **BEFORE DEPARTURE**, it must be impressed on all vessels that decisions related to safety issues are theirs, **AND ONLY THEIRS** to make, and that they are not required to follow the decisions of anyone else on the cruise!

CRUISE NOTES

WANT TO GET AWAY EARLY?? If you want to get away early, say Friday during the day and yet may be interested in knowing what has been decided for that weekend's cruise, **LEAVE A NOTE** for the cruise leader on be window of the club noticeboard (on the wall, between the men's and women's entrance to the washrooms). Leave **NAME, BOAT NAME, VHF CALL SIGN**. Cruise leader will try to contact you with details of the cruise, Saturday morning after the skippers meeting as he/she leaves Collins Bay if you are within range, and are monitoring Channel 16.

PLANNING A CRUISE?? Unless you are planning something very private and exclusive, why not advertise? Leave details of your plans on the club noticeboard. Name, boat name, VHF call sign, planned destination, likely cruising area, departure and return dates, etc. In this way, other club members with similar ideas can keep a weather eye peeled for you. You never know, a happy chance meeting of fellow cruisers may add a pleasant dimension to your cruise holiday.

THE COHRS AND THE CAMERONS: Norman and Maxine Cohrs and Merv. and Marion Cameron are planning a cruise into Lake Huron/Georgian Bay via Lake Erie. Their planned departure date is somewhere around June 4th. with an expected return of July 15. If you are interested in their plans, or are expecting to be in the vicinity in that time period, give them a call on Almitra (Cohrs) or Sueno (Camerons).

REMEMBER: This year, purposefully, many of our cruises do not have predetermined destinations. We are planning to let the wind and skipper preference set the direction. If you plan to participate on a cruise weekend, show up at the skippers meeting on **Saturday morning at 9:30**, at which time the destination for the day will be set. In that way you will know where boats plan to congregate between approximately 4:30 and 6:00. You then can cruise with the rest in a pack, or, if more than one route to the destination is available follow your own preference.

SAFETY AND THE CRUISE LEADER: Remember **ONLY YOU** are responsible for the safety of your vessel and crew. If a squall line comes through and the prudent thing to do is to seek shelter, then regardless of what others may do, as far as your boat and your crew is concerned the decision is **YOURS**. The Cruise Leader is primarily a **COORDINATOR OF COMMUNICATIONS, ONLY**. You should monitor the channel chosen, and when appropriate let the Cruise Leader know what your plans are. If you drop out and don't tell anyone, you may find that the Coast Guard are looking for you. We plan to publish the duties of the Cruise Leader in this or a subsequent issue of the Mixer.





